

# Xbox to Xbox Ftp Guide

This tutorial shows you to how to transfer files between two Xbox's with auto-detect. No computer is needed.

All Promods Xbox's from software version Ninja 3 onwards have Xbox to Xbox FTP, if you do not have Ninja 3 or newer this tutorial will not work for you. Both Xbox's need to have Ninja 3 or newer.

## 1. Setup

You will need a network crossover cable, or Xbox system-link cable.

Plug both Xbox's in and connect the crossover cable between them.

If you only have one TV, connect the Xbox that you are copying the files TO (the Destination Xbox) to the TV.

Important note: Both Xbox's need to have an AV cable plugged into the back of the Xbox. The Xbox that has all the files on it to be copied (the Source Xbox) should be left unplugged from the TV but still have its AV cable in the back of the Xbox.

## 2. Change the IP address

All Promods Xbox's have a default IP address of 192.168.0.10

Change the IP address of the Xbox that's plugged into the TV to 192.168.0.11

Procedure: From main menu select 'Settings'

Select 'Network'

Select 'IP Address'

Change to '192.168.0.11' and click 'E' to Save

Press 'Back' on your controller, you will be asked to save and reboot, choose Yes.

The Xbox's are now both setup, ensure everything is connected and configured as above, turn both Xbox's on, wait for the Xbox plugged into the TV to display an Autodetect message as below, this should happen within 15 seconds.

Picture below shows the auto-detect window appearing if you have everything setup correct.



### 3. Copying Files

From the main menu select 'Filemanager'

The File Manager screen is split into two sides, think of the left side as the Source Xbox that's not plugged into the TV, the right side is the Destination Xbox that's plugged into the TV.



Select 'Ninja XBOX' on the left side of the screen. This allows you to browse the Source Xbox.



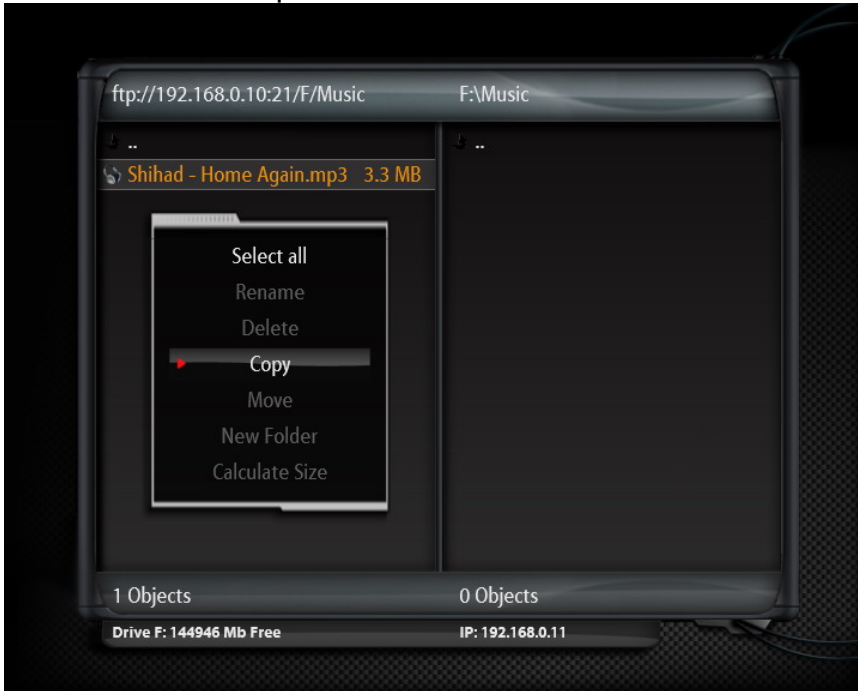
Go to the right side of the screen and open the destination folder.

For this tutorial we will copy some Music, go to the right side of the screen, select Music and open the folder.

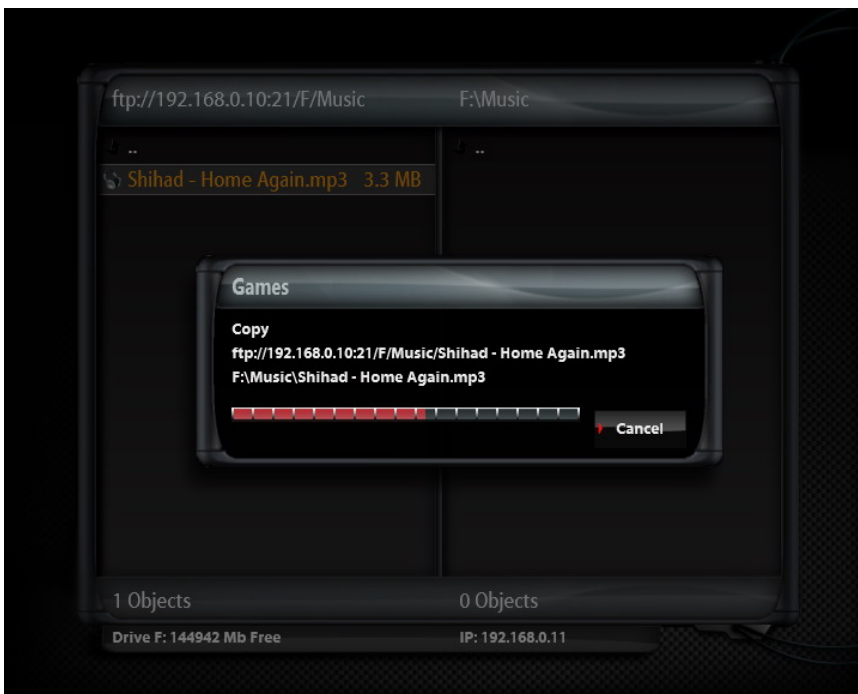
Now go back to the left side of the screen and open the Music folder.

Highlight a Music file and press the 'White' button, then select 'Copy'.

The screen should look as below, the left side of the screen has selected a Music file to copy, the right side of the screen shows the Music Folder open ready for Music files to be copied into.



Pic below shows the copy progress bar.



Music file successfully copied.



To copy multiple folders or files, press 'Y' to mark. Mark as many folders/files as you wish, then press 'White' to select 'Copy'.

Remember to copy folders/files to their correct location.

For Games, open the Games folder on the destination Xbox, then mark all the Games folders on the Source Xbox and select Copy.

The same applies for Movies and Pictures.

You can also watch Movies and listen to Music from another Xbox, just click 'A' on the movie or music file to play it.
